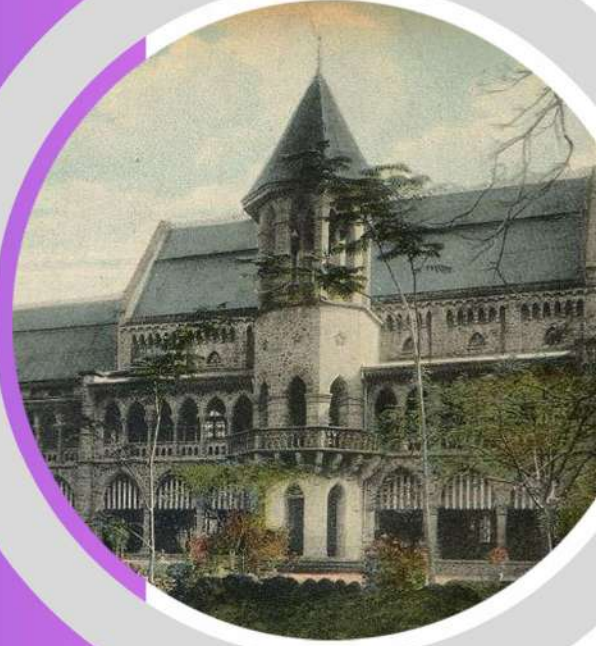

Essential Qualification: Students with a Master's Degree in A.I.H.C. and Archaeology/History with 55% or B+ grade (with specialisation in Ancient History/Ancient Indian Culture/Indology from UGC recognized University)

- Only 2 candidates will be selected through the interview process.
